Children's Chapel during the 10.30 a.m. service

Children ages 3 years through 5th grade are welcome to gather in the Children's Chapel (second floor) for singing, a Bible reading, and prayer.

3-year-olds-Kindergartners may be brought directly to the Children's Chapel by their families, or if they are already in their childcare room, they will be accompanied to and from Chapel by the childcare staff.

1st-5th grades begin the 10.30 service with their families and exit for Chapel during the "Gloria" Hymn of Praise. They will re-join their families at the Peace.

Please note that during the summer, Chapel for all ages (3 years through 5th Grade) will be held in the 2nd floor Children's Chapel.

Christian Formation 9.15-10.15 a.m.

There will be two offerings in the summer. We recognize the variety of summer plans and schedules that parishioners may have, but please do not hesitate to attend these classes even if you will be away for one or more Sundays!
